Wallem Group manages Tankers, PCTC, Containers, Bulk and Reefer vessels. I was responsible for the HSSEQ functions for the entire Wallem fleet, and for the learning and development of over 4,000 seafarers on Wallem managed vessels. In my time the incident investigation methodologies were improved for better learning, resulting in an overall reduction of incidents and loss. I have experience with investigations involving collision, grounding, fatalities, and major fires. I introduced the behavioural competency framework and auditing mechanisms for its verification. During my tenure, tanker fleets went through several TMSA audits and improved their overall score. Rightship score for the company was at 5/5 with improved scoring for the fleets.

From 2008 to 2012, I managed a fleet of 13 Cape size bulk vessels, owned by Berge Bulk, trading ores between South America/Australia and China.

As a General Manager, Marine, for BW Singapore, I introduced TapRoot® in the organisation and improved the incident investigation processes. I led the Zero Harm program in BW Group.

I was Head of Fleets (VP), from 2012 to 2017, leading a large team across Safety, Marine, Technical & Manning departments and managing 1,800 multinational

seafarers, focusing on quality and training. I was responsible for all dry dockings and new building projects and lay up for some of BW's VLCC's.

I led projects developing a customized Quality Management System and implementing a Behavioural Competency Management platform in BW.

From 2013 to date, I have worked with Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (MPA) and Singapore Shipping Association (SSA) on key industry issues involving safety of navigation and harbour safety. I have spoken at public events organised by MPA on several occasions since 2015. I have also moderated panels on 'Container Safety' for MPA (2021) and on 'Modern Day Navigation' for Nautical Institute (2022).
